Young cardiologists, internal medicine, endocrinologists, interventional cardiologists, and cardiovascular surgeons **under the age of 35 years** are invited to participate in the **Young investigators Award** with presentations of original research results.

All abstracts should be send to the Organizing Committee (young@scardio.ru) with the subject line " Young investigators Award " and should include:

- information about the authors (full name, position, place of work, city, contact phone number, email address);
- an abstract (font Times New Roman 12-14, line spacing 1.5, no more than 500 words, including title, full name and affiliations, background, aim, methods, results, and conclusions).

The work will be eligible for the final competition based on the decision of independent experts.

The deadline for submitting applications for the Young investigators Award is **January 15, 2025.**

The results of the review will be sent via email by **February 28, 2025.**

The final procedure of the Young investigators Award includes an oral presentation during 7 minutes.
