Successful launch of the ARMI registry

ARMI is the **first national registry of myocardial infarction in Armenia**. The **Armenian Cardiologists Association** organized the research project in collaboration with the **Santé Arménie French-Armenian Academic Research Organization (FAARO)**. The work on the project has been started since 2022 and a lot of effort has been devoted to the successful launch of the project. **The Ministry of Health of the RA has expressed its support for the project.**

ARMI was also registered on the [ClinicalTrials.gov](https://clinicaltrials.gov), where you can see the recruiting centers.



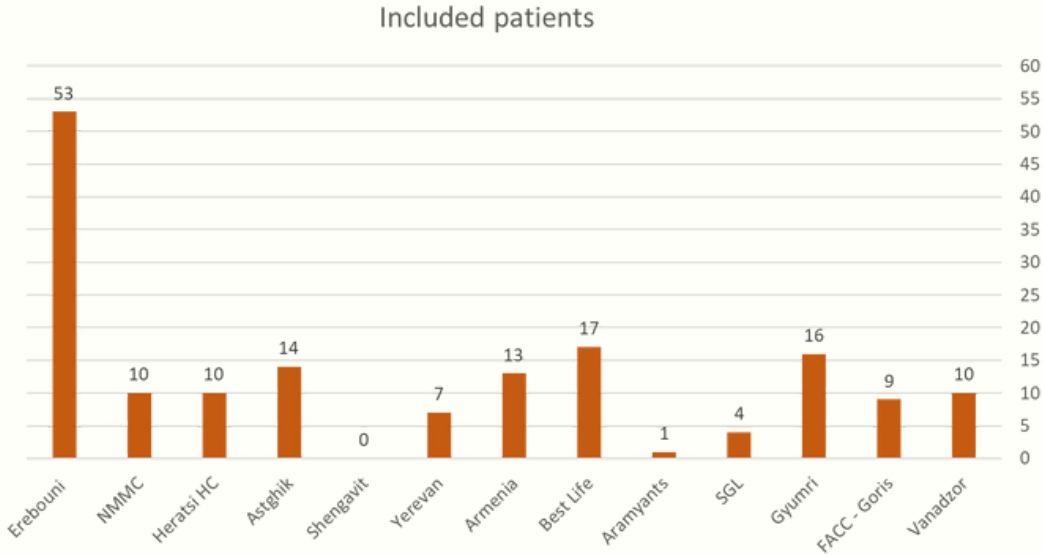
On **February 16 2023**, the registry was approved by the Ethics Committee of the Yerevan State Medical University.

During **December 2023**, the activation of all the participating centers started and was successfully completed. 13 centers are participating, 3 of which are in regions: *Erebuni MC, Nork Marash MC, Heratsi Hospital Complex, Astghik MC, Shengavit MC, Yerevan Scientific Medical Center, Armenia MC, Best Life MC, Aramyants MC, Saint G. Illuminator MC, Gyumri MC, French-Armenian Cardiovascular Center, Vnanadzor MC.*
